#### PRO BONO APPELLATE MEDIATOR PANEL APPLICATION

The United States Court of Appeals for the Second Circuit is accepting applications for the Court's Pro Bono Appellate Mediator Panel. The Panel is authorized by Local Rule 33.1, and is governed by the Second Circuit's Pro Bono Appellate Mediator Panel Plan. Members of the Pro Bono Appellate Mediator Panel serve as volunteer mediators for counseled, civil appeals.

All applicants must be attorneys admitted to, and in good standing with, the bar of the Second Circuit or the bar of a state within the Second Circuit. Applicants must have 10 years of legal experience and substantial mediation experience.

The Panel's size is limited; therefore, the Court cannot appoint every qualified applicant. The membership term is three years, subject to a limit of two consecutive terms.
